Slain nurse's family sues

WINDSOR, Ont.—The family of a murdered Ontario nurse has launched a \$13.5 million lawsuit against her hospital and her killer's spouse.

Lori Dupont, 36, was stabbed to death at the Hotel Dieu Grace in Windsor by her former boyfriend, Dr. Marc Daniel, on Nov. 12. Daniel, an anesthetist, was found unconscious in his car from an apparent drug overdose and died later.

Also named are senior administrators at the hospital and Daniel's psychiatrist.

The family claims Dupont lived in fear for the last few months of her life, and her killing should have been prevented.

Their lawyer, Greg Monforton, says the hospital allowed Daniel into the facility even though it knew he was mentally unstable.

Daniel had first tried to kill himself in February 2005, but was back in surgery by June.
